RICS works with the faculty oversight committees to promote the ethical and responsible conduct of research and to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements relating to research involving human participants, vertebrate animal subjects, biological materials, recombinant/synthetic nucleic acids, biohazards, radiation hazards, chemical hazards, and stem cells.
